

<u>West Virginia Mission Trip</u> Sunday, July 16- Friday, July 21

Purpose: This trip with World Vision provides a unique opportunity to unite with your family and church for practical service and ministry to a community with significant physical and spiritual needs.

Ministry: Your week will be a combination of work projects, team activities, and free time. The work site will either be at a home, church, or community center. The type of project will depend on our group's skills and the needs of the community (anything from painting to light renovations). The week will break-down as follows:

Accommodations: The team will stay at a local college dorm on the grounds of Alderson-Broaddus College. Families will stay together in 3-room suites (2 to a room). Breakfast and dinner will be eaten at the college dining hall. Lunches will be prepared and eaten on site.

Preparation: In addition to following the payment and form schedule below, you'll need to attend several team meetings before the trip for training and team building. The day and time of these meetings will be arranged with the group.

Cost & Support Raising: Your payment covers all housing, meals, and construction supply costs. Transportation arrangements will be determined later. Each family is responsible for their own transportation, but don't forget that travel-related costs are tax deductible*. You are encouraged to send support letters to family and friends outside the church. The church will collect an offering for the trip on a specified Sunday that will be distributed evenly among the team. Cost is as follows:

- Over age 10 \$450
- Ages 5-10 \$260

- May 28 remaining **\$400 payment** (\$210 for ages 5-10)

- We commit to pay the full cost of the trip through our own income and/or support raising.
- We will make it a priority to attend all team meetings and will review all material covered in meetings we cannot attend.
- We commit, by God's grace, to live in a Christ-like way in our attitudes, speech, and behavior while on the trip.
- We understand that, in order to meet the physical needs of the community, we will be expected to work hard and get dirty.
- We understand that, in order to meet the spiritual needs of the community, we will be expected to share our faith and pray for those we meet as God gives us opportunity.
- We intend to follow the direction and leadership of Living Hope Church and World Vision while on the trip.
