

**Purpose:** This trip is in support of Source of Life Ministries in Haiti (sourceoflifeministries.com). This ministry provides housing, education, and spiritual growth for orphaned children. We'll be involved in practical work projects as well as ministry to the children and community.

**Participants:** The trip is open to youth and adults. We recommend age 13 and older but if you are interested in coming with younger children, please speak to the leadership. Because of housing we are limited to 12 people. We are looking for people from all walks of life – those with skilled construction experience, those who can work hard in support roles, and those with a heart to serve the children and staff.

**Ministry:** The week will be a combination of work projects on the facility, ministry with the kids, and community outreach. Our schedule will tentatively be arranged as follows:

**Travel:** We will fly together to Port-au-Prince Haiti and take ground transportation about two hours outside the city to the safe house. Jacque Merine, founder and director of the ministry, will meet us at the airport and serve as our guide and translator for the trip.

Accommodations: The team will stay in a modern guest house with electricity and indoor plumbing at the nearby Haiti Health Ministries (haitihealthministries.org). Breakfast and dinner will be eaten at the guest house. We'll eat lunch on site with the children.

**Preparation:** We'll have 3-4 team meetings before we go for training and team building. You'll need to turn in payment and forms according to the schedule below. Additionally, you'll need to secure your passport and fulfill any medical preparations recommended by your doctor.

**Cost & Support Raising:** The total cost for all transportation, housing, will be around **\$1,200** (depending on final flight expenses). NOTE: all travel-related costs and participant fees are tax deductible\*. You are encouraged to send support letters to family and friends outside the church. The church will collect an offering for the trip on a specified Sunday that will be distributed evenly among the team. Please note these dates for payments and forms:

- March 3 \$200 deposit, registration form, and photocopy of passport
- April 28 \$500 payment
- May 26 \$500 (or remaining balance if price changes)

Please annotate all checks in the memo field "Haiti". Payments can be made weekly, monthly, or as specified above – whatever works best for you. *Please give your checks to your team leader or Donna Sue Bongardt*.

**Registration:** Please fill-in your registration form completely (one per person) and return to Donna Sue Bongardt or the church office. Checks and donations should be made out to Living Hope Church with "Haiti" in the memo line. Please tell all sponsors that donations are tax deductible.
