Some Key Passages

1 Corinthians 15:1-4. Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures

2 Timothy 2:8 (NIV). Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead, descended from David. This is my gospel

Passages that Preach the gospel

John 3:16-18 - "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

1 Peter 3:18 - Christ suffered to bring us to God

Romans 6:23 - Dead in sin, eternal life in Christ

Ephesians 2:1-10 - Dead in Sin, Made alive in Christ

Romans 3:21-26 - Statement on Justification

God, through the perfect life, atoning death, and bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ, rescues all his people from the wrath of God into peace with God, with a promise of the full restoration of his created order forever--all to the praise of the glory of his grace.¹

The gospel is that Christ died for our sins and He rose and through faith in Him we can be reconciled to the Father.²

God has entered the world in Jesus Christ to achieve a salvation that we could not achieve for ourselves which now 1) converts and transforms individuals, forming them into a new humanity, and eventually 2) will renew the whole world and all creation.³

The Gospel Announcement: Jesus is Savior and Lord

Adoption - Identity as God's Child (Gal 4:4-7; 1 John 3:1-3)

Regeneration - New Life with God (1 Peter 1:3; 2 Cor 5:17)

Sanctification - Purity in God (Rom 6:22; 1 Pet 1:2






Gospel Arrows (Jesus came, died for sin, rose again, ascended, is returning)
