 - New Creation 2 Corinthians 5:17
 - Being born again/born from above John 3, 1 Peter 1
 - Being born of God John 1:13, 1 John 2:29, 3:9, 4:7; 5:1,4,18
 - Being made alive (with Christ, from the dead) Eph 2: 5, 10; Col 2:13

- How does regeneration happen? Do we play any part in it? When does it occur.
- The new birth enable us to respond to the gospel call. Tell us about your conversion. When did it happen and what do you remember about it?
