



“Who is a God like you?”

Micah 7

The world falls into corruption and confusion (vs. 1-6)

- What is similar and what is different about the circumstances Micah is facing and our circumstances?
- What has your response been to our current crisis? How would you describe the state of your heart?

The people wait for God’s salvation (vs. 7-13)

- What does it mean to wait for God’s salvation? How does his eternal salvation relate to our temporal hardships?
- Consider the three things we learn about waiting in Micah 7:7 - Wait with Attention, Wait with Expectation, Wait with Communication. How can you practically live those out this week?

The Shepherd pardons and restores his people (vs. 14-19)

- How do we see the Lord as our Shepherd in this passage. Look back at Micah 5 also. What does this mean to you?
- Who is a God like our God? List out the 8 wonderful ways God works for our salvation in verses 18-20. How does this encourage your heart?
